- ❁ **Order pinwheels (up to 40 per location) and lawn signs**

- ❁ **“Plant” them in the ground outside of your building; see examples above!**

- ❁ **Put them in vases in your hallways or offices. Place child safety pamphlets or notices (see next page) nearby to let people know what it’s all about.**
