OVERVIEW OF AGREEMENT DIOCESE OF MANCHESTER AND THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

The Agreement recites that:

- 1) The State initiated the process and it was identified as a criminal investigation.
- 2) The State invoked the authority of the Grand Jury which has significant authority in common law and state law.
- 3) The Diocese cooperated in the State's investigation.
- 4) The State indicates their intention to indict the Diocese.
- 5) The Diocese acknowledges that the State has evidence likely to sustain a conviction and, in the interest of the common good, consented to this Agreement.

The Diocese and the State agree to settle by Agreement to,

- 1) protect victims from the necessity of testifying in a criminal trial;
- 2) establish terms and conditions that will facilitate the protection of children to a greater extent than a criminal conviction and sentence; and
- 3) ensure a system of accountability, oversight, transparency, and training.

The salient points of the Agreement include:

- 1) The State agrees not to prosecute the Diocese.
- 2) The Diocese re-affirms its commitment to the mandatory reporting law for suspicion of child abuse or neglect.
 - The Diocese commits to common responsibility of church personnel to report suspicions of any other church personnel who may have sexually abused a child.
 - The Diocese commits to report suspicions made known by adults who allege child abuse as a minor.
 - The Diocese re-commits to a signed acknowledgement by all church personnel.
 - The Diocese re-commits to full cooperation with civil authority in investigations.
 - The Diocese re-commits to administrative leave for accused persons.
- 3) The Diocese re-commits to on-going training of all church personnel.
- 4) The Diocese agrees to an annual compliance audit by the State for a period of five (5) years.
- 5) The Diocese agrees to public disclosure of the Agreement.
- 6) The State commits to a public Report which includes their investigative files and the use of diocesan files obtained in their investigation (exclusively related to child sexual abuse).
 - The Diocese waives Grand Jury confidentiality for the above noted documents only. The State agrees not to disclose mental health or medical records, but may cite from them.
 - The State agrees to allow the Diocese to review and dispute the public Report ten (10) days prior to its release.
 - The Diocese agrees to allow the State to review any public Response by the Diocese five (5) days prior to its release (no dispute right to State).
- 7) The Diocese and the State agree to right of amendment and to a "sunset provision" before the Superior Court on or before December 31, 2007.
- 8) The Diocese and the State agree to Superior Court jurisdiction for resolution of disputes regarding the Agreement.
